Winscales Parish Council is made up of Seven Councillors of which we have Five in Office leaving Two vacancies. Allerdale Borough Council have appointed temporary councillors to enable meetings to be held and to continue parish business.

If we cannot recruit enough people to sit on the parish council the only option is for Winscales Parish Council to be dissolved and that instead the area becomes part of Workington Town Council. If you don't want to lose the parish council then please consider joining the council or ask friends and family if they are interested.

We know that your time is precious, so the parish council only meets by-monthly (January-March-May-July-September-November) for about 1-2 hours to discuss parish matters i.e., planning applications, footpaths, pothole, and other issues as well as projects and funding to enhance the parish to name a few.
